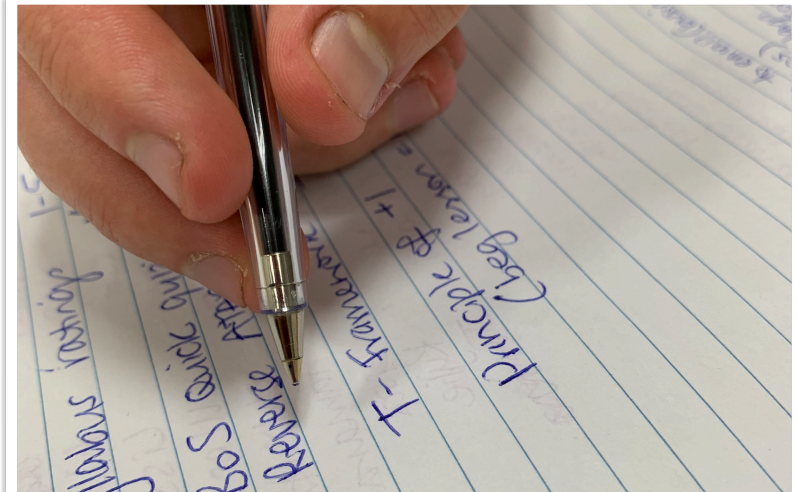

The 3 HSC Questions You Will Be Asked



The generic question

General question about the concept of the module

E.g. To what extent are the individual and collective experiences central to the human experiences of your studied text?

The form specific question

How does the text type affect meaning?

E.g. Prose fiction relies primarily on setting to create cultural tension. To what extent do you agree with this statement?

The text specific question

Question about your studied text in the module

E.g. To what extent are power struggles central to the human experiences in The Merchant of Venice?
